A LOCAL LAW

To amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to street name, Throgs Neck expressway extension, borough of the Bronx.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section B4-60.0 of the administrative code of the city of New York is hereby amended by adding thereto a new designation to read as follows:

§ B4-60.0 **Bronx: Change certain street name.**—The following street name is hereby designated as hereinafter indicated:

New name	Present name	Limits
Throgs Neck expressway extension	None	The service road on the southerly side of the Cross Bronx expressway between Sampson avenue and Longstreet avenue.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.

The Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs to which was referred on June 14, 1973 (Minutes, page 1154), the annexed local law respectfully

REPORTS:

This proposed law would amend the administrative code by naming the service road on the southerly side of the Cross Bronx Expressway between Sampson Avenue and Longstreet Avenue.

This service road is unofficially referred to by different names at the intersection between East Tremont Avenue and Pennyfield Avenue.

Accordingly your Committee recommends its adoption.

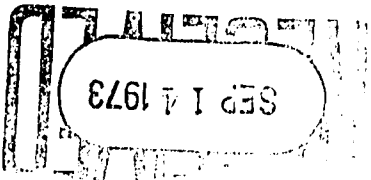


It should be noted, however, that in line 8 under present name it should be made to read East 177th Street.
