In addition to his work with the Little League, he was extremely active and held executive posts in numerous organizations, such as the Rosebank Boys Club and Labetti Post V.F.W.

Dennis Torricelli was an outstanding civic leader who tirelessly served his community. The street to be named in his honor is adjacent to the headquarters of the East Shore Little League.

The Committee on Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs to which was referred on January 7, 1981 (Minutes, page 53) the annexed local law, respectfully

REPORTS:

Dennis A. Torricelli, Sr., was born March 5, 1925. He was the founder and served as President of the East Shore Little League for over twenty years. Mr. Torricelli also served as President of the Rosebank Boys Club and as the Senior Vice-Commander of Labetti Post V.F.W., and was active in the International Longshoreman's Association.

He fought in Europe during World War Two and was the recipient of the Good Conduct Medal and the World War Two Victory Medal. Mr. Torricelli was also a past honoree of the Borough President's Citizenship Award given for outstanding community service.

The street to be renamed is where the East Shore Little League is now head-quartered. The bill is supported by many public officials, Community Groups and private citizens.

City Planning has stated that the designation conforms to the city map. Accordingly your committee recommends its adoption.

My technical staff has analyzed the proposed street name change from Summer Street to Dennis Torricelli Sr. St. from Lyman Ave to School Road in the borough of Staten Island as it relates to the Police Department's emergency dispatch system (SPRINT).

This proposed change can be accommodated in the SPRINT system by adding it as an alias street name for Summer St. Since SPRINT allows a maximum of ten characters in any street name and non-unique first names, titles, pre-names and initials are dropped. It will be known in the computer system as "Torricelli St" for the entire length of Summer St. in the borough of Staten Island.

This alias street name will be added to our files when we are notified, in writing, that the proposal has been adopted.

He was also honored with the Borough Presidents Outstanding Citizenship Medal for his work in the community. Mr. Torricelli fought for his country courageously in Europe during World War Two and was the recipient of the Good Conduct Medal, the World War Two Victory Medal, and the Combat Infantry Badge. After reading the above I hope you will find it in your heart to vote in the affimative manner. Dennis gave of himself for others, and it is only right for the people give something back to memorialize Dennis for his work in the community service field.
